5. Define Management by Objectives (MBO) and discuss its impact on organizational performance. How can MBO be effectively implemented in the aviation sector?
6. Explain the concept of leadership and its different styles. How can effective leadership influence the performance of employees in the aviation industry?
7. Discuss the concept of human resource development (HRD) and its importance in the aviation industry. Provide examples of successful HRD initiatives that have led to improved organizational performance.
