3. What are the different theories of organization? Explain the benefits of organizing and types of organizational structures.
4. What is Departmentation? Explain its principles, process and patterns used in departmentation.
5. Define directing and what are its characteristics? Explain the concept of direction through motivation. Describe the objectives, significance and different theories of motivation.
6. What are the nature and functions of leadership? What are the different styles, skills and attitudes of leaders?
7. *"In management, the functions of planning, organizing, and directing set the pace, while control ensures that results are achieved in line with the goals and objectives decided by the manager."* Explain the concept of control, its characteristics and importance. What are the pre-requisites of a good control system?
