1. Seeta Rani was handcuffed and taken to a police station at 11.30 PM. Vijay, a police officer arrested and questioned her in the police station. She did not cooperate with the officer and refused to tell the truth. The allegation against Seeta is that she killed her step daughter and threw her dead body into a river. As Seeta is not at all cooperating, Vijay had to beat her to know the truth. Then seta confessed to the crime. The dead body of her step daughter was recovered as per the statement of Seeta. Examine whether the procedure followed in the given case is correct. Quote the relevant provisions and cases.
2. What are the rights available to prisoners in Jail?
3. Akhila had beaten up her husband, Baahubali as a result of which he lost one eye and a tooth. Baahubali filed a complaint against Akhila after 10 days of the incident. Akhila confessed to the crime in the police station. Examine the issues and procedure involved in registering the FIR and recording the confession of the crime as per the provisions of Cr.P.C.
4. Explain the procedure of trial in sessions court. What are the powers given to the judge to conduct the trial by Code of Criminal Procedure?
5. What is the role of the prosecutor in a criminal trial? Enumerate the powers and responsibilities of the prosecutor.
