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Answer the following questions:

1. "Its very difficult to understand the nature of the crime and to define crime. May be its possible to an extent if we discuss about the elements of crime". Explain **(25 Marks)**
2. Mr Bhanu is running a website by name "baba.com". He wanted to upload devotional videos on his platform. Slowly the website gained popularity and thousands of videos used to get uploaded every day. The procedure which every customer has to follow while uploading is, they have to give an undertaking that the content of the video belongs to the spiritual category. One Mr Sonu signed the agreement and uploaded a porn video of his girlfriend on 22.01.2022 at 8AM. Two three people who watched the video were shocked by the content and complained to the management at about 9 AM. The management took four days to conduct the enquiry and to delete the content from the platform. Mr Sonu defaced the website after the content was deleted. Check whether Mr Sonu has committed any offence? If yes explain with the help of relevant cases and law. Discuss the liability of the internet service provider in the given factual situation.

"In this digital age, people knowingly or unknowingly share sensitive personal data on various digital platforms such as e-commerce sites, mobile apps, webinar platforms, net banking, e-wallets etc. The users of these platforms give permission to use the personal data by simply ticking on 'I agree with the terms and conditions' with or without reading the Privacy Policy. This security vulnerability leaves millions of users susceptible to hackers and various threat actors." Discuss with the help of data protection guide lines and the bill in India.
