NALSAR Pro Programme – An overview

- The duration of the course is for one year.
- The maximum period for completion of the Course is 2 academic years including the year of admission.
- The course syllabus is broadly divided into 4 papers.
- 48 hours of class room interactivity will be covered in the eight-days exercise which will be held in two rounds

Teaching and Learning Strategy

Reading Material –

- The candidates are provided with the print copies of reading materials prepared by Subject experts.
- The reading materials cover the detailed syllabi of the course.
- Such materials have to be supplemented by the candidate with their own readings on the internet or other available materials as they cover broad parameters.
- Pay attention to PPTs too.

Online Support –

- the soft copy of the reading materials, the power point presentations and video lectures of the contact seminar classes and previous year question papers are made available on the website
- The access to the website will be deactivated after the completion of the academic year and will be revived on continuation of the course after payment of the continuation fee for each academic year.
- The recorded videos of the classes will be uploaded on the dedicated website for the convenience of the candidates who could not attend the classes.

- The class room learning to be an interactive process .
- Such process ensures that the enrolled candidates are co learners with the instructors contributing to the learning process
- DDE-NALSAR courses – a knowledge space rather than merely a market oriented learning.

Examination

- They will be held on two days – Sat & Sun.
- The schedule of examinations shall be issued at least 30 (thirty) days ahead of the examinations.
- Annual Examinations will be held every year during the month of May/June at Hyderabad.
- The Supplementary Examinations will be conducted in the month of November / December at Hyderabad
