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1. Mr. Sunil a Police Officer arrested a Social Activist Mr. Arun on a fake allegation made by one Business man Mr. Supaari. Sunil tied Arun to a jeep and brought to the police station. Sunil tortured Arun for few days and pressurised to give confession. Then Sunil tried to arrest Arun's wife. He went to her house and brought her in an auto at 12'o clock in the night. She was detained in the lockup for three days. On the fourth day, three constables raped her in the police station in front of her husband. Next day Sunil and other constables took Arun out of the police station on some pretext. After two days Arun's dead body was found in a bus stop. Examine the procedural lapses committed in the given situation with the help of decided cases and relevant provisions.

2. As per the prosecution case Sonu stabbed his father with a knife. Then he went to the police station and filed an FIR stating that he saw his father in a pool of blood. Police started investigation and found that Sonu is involved in his father's murder. Investigating officer (I O) arrested Sonu and started interrogation. IO asked Sonu to sign the statements made during his examination. Then Sonu took the IO to his house and showed the place where he had hidden the blood stained knife. Immediately he was taken to the nearest Magistrate to record the confession. The Magistrate recorded the confession and sent him to police custody. Examine the lapses in the procedure and the relevance of the recovery of knife as evidence in the given situation with the help of relevant cases and law. **(20 marks)**
